JOB PURPOSE

The CP Advisor will offer technical support across all areas of work of the International Programmes Division and shapes and supervises the technical implementation of child protection interventions.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Ensure technical supervision to child protection programmes
- Working closely with relevant sectors/areas of the Organisation, develop high quality concept notes and proposals, and ensure technical engagement with donors' technical advisers if present.
- Ensures alignment of CP interventions with the Global Child protection strategy and approaches defined within Save the Children Child Protection Global Initiative. Participate to CP Global Initiative working groups, as requested. Tracks SC Italy contribution to the achievement of the Global CP Indicators.
- Support Portfolio Department in the identification of CP technical support needed at country and regional level, including in terms of training needs.
- Provide technical support to CP teams in the field and if required conduct monitoring visits to ensure quality programming is being implemented.
- Develop methodologies, training modules and materials and support the development and implementation of a capacity building plan on CP for field-based teams and key partners where required.
- Support other sectors/ areas of the Organisation in the preparation of timely programme and donor reports on child protection project activities in compliance with internal requirements and any relevant external donor requirements.
- In coordination with MEAL experts, ensure that M&E systems are in place and all required project indicators are included in CP proposals, measured by field teams and evaluated.
- In coordination with MEAL experts, document lessons learnt, best practice and case studies to contribute to broader sector learning in Save the Children.
- Contribute to the development of key policy positions and messages on CP, including in support of programmatic, advocacy and communication work."
- Develop technical materials in the specific thematic area in support of the drafting of documents for advocacy, communication and/or fundraising purposes, including in support of engagement towards Institutional Donors.
- In collaboration with other sectors/ areas of the Organisation, assist in child protection advocacy, communication and marketing activities.
- Comply with Save the Children policies and practice with respect to child protection, code of conduct, health and safety, equal opportunities and other relevant policies and procedures, code of conduct, equal opportunities and other relevant policies.



EDUCATION, SKILLS AND EXPERIENCE REQUIRED

- Degree in Social Sciences, International Relations, Development studies or similar fields
- Experience of at least 3 years of working internationally in CP programs
- Technical knowledge on rights based approaches, and in CP areas, especially on migration and violence against children
- Excellent written and spoken English and Italian; good knowledge of French, Spanish and/or Portuguese preferred
- Proven ability of mentoring, coaching and training on CP related topics
- Excellent writing, communications and networking skills in Italian and English
- Very good research skills
- Advocacy skills are preferable
